## SAT Results KS2

This week we received our SAT results back for our Y6 pupils. I have included them below on a table for you with the national results for 2017 so you can compare how we have done with the national averages. The 2018 national averages have yet to be confirmed but are set to be very similar to 2017.

I am sure you will agree these results are spectacular and we are so proud of all our children and how they performed. A huge well done to all of them and all the staff team who have supported them on their journey to the end of Y6.

The overall school results are below. Each child is worth 3% at our school.

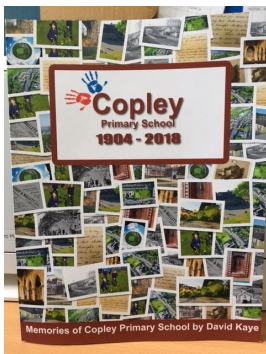
