Attendance

Attendance in school this year is 94.9% significantly below our target of 96%. Every day that a child is absent from school has an impact on their attainment and that of the other children in their class. If a child misses teaching, the class teacher has to take the time to enable them to catch up.

During this academic year, **39 families** have taken unauthorised, extended leave and this has inevitably had a negative impact on both our attendance and progress data.

We would like to remind parents to contact school before 8.40 a.m. if their child is going to be absent. If there is no response to texts or telephone calls, a home visit will be necessary for safeguarding reasons.
