### Highlights from the week

I wanted to share with you some key highlights that we already have for the week:

- 4596 activities took place across the UK during the week
- Every constituency had at least 1 activity take place and on average we had 7 per constituency
- The Isle of Wight was the constituency with the most activity, with 32 events taking place
