- (re: 13) larger portions for my son whose in year 4. The teaching team are excellent. Easy to approach and work so hard, especially with the new curriculum. We appreciate how hard everyone works as it mustn't be easy!
- I really like the school but I feel too much homework is handed out – I feel too pressured to get the work done to an acceptable standard.
- On an evening the gate seems to be opening quite late, sometimes a minute before the bell rings. I find it quite difficult to get past the Year1 & 2s with a pushchair if they are coming down the walk way at the same time.
- I would like to see 2 trips per academic year being planned. Children learn better by experiencing things. I also believe that learning outside the classroom should be promoted as much as possible. I understand that budget is tight but extra sports clubs before or after school would be welcome (netball, cross country, running are 3 options that don't require equipment).
- Afternoon playtime, disagree with it being cut. Why?
- (re:14) Although the school promotes healthy eating I strongly feel it is wrong to sell sweets/ice lollies with very high sugar content on the school playground on such a regular basis. It should be kept to a monthly or end of term treat.
- Jess does not like mince for school lunches, but otherwise she enjoys the food.
- Reggie likes lunches but would like bigger portions.
- Concerned with writing for SATs.
- Offering healthier snacks before, during, after school instead of sweets. A nurturing group for children who are struggling. More groups offered such as maths, reading, and homework. I think this would help children who are finding these difficult. The chance of more interesting school trips throughout the year groups.
- I have disagreed with the curriculum question due to the level of work. This is no fault of the school and the teachers work hard to follow the curriculum. I just think the level of work has been pushed up to a level that is a bit high for some children.
- Too much homework for all year groups. Small portions in school dinners.
- I understand that afternoon breaks are no longer compulsory and are infrequent. I personally do not agree with this and feel if your child is hardworking and has completed all their work they should be entitled to a break. They are still only young and need this time to take a breather, play and go to the toilet.
- I think that the PTA are selling every day and this is getting a bit much, and find that it's getting a bit expensive. I think they need to stick to the Friday only as when it started (summer term only).
