PARENTAL PERMISSIONS TO LEAVE SCHOOL UNACCOMPANIED AT THE END OF A SCHOOL DAY

Years 5 & 6 are allowed to leave school at the end of the school day unaccompanied by an adult if prior permission is given in writing by an adult with parental responsibility for that child.

However, in the event that the school believe that if a child was allowed to leave school unaccompanied, that that child would be at risk to themselves or others, the school will complete an individual risk assessment to ascertain the level of risk. Once complete, the parent/carer will be consulted to discuss the way forward, to ensure the child's needs are met.
