Things to remember

1. If your child is poorly please call the school office before 10am or as early in the morning as possible. Please select Option 1 on the telephone menu and leave details of name, class and reason for absence.
2. Please make sure your child has full PE kit, clearly labelled, on sports activity days. PE kit consists of white T-shirt, black shorts and black pumps. In the colder weather, for outdoor activities children can wear trainers and dark jogging bottoms.

Holidays during term time

Please remember, the law gives no entitlement to parents to take their child on holiday during term time. Any application for leave can only be in exceptional circumstances and the Head Teacher must be satisfied that the circumstances are exceptional and warrant the granting of leave.

"Head Teachers would not be expected to class any term time holiday as exceptional and parents can be fined by the Local Authority for taking their child on holiday during term time".

Year 1, 3 & 5 took part in our annual 'Road Safety' walks and discussions.


House points 'Dahl' was the overall winning house this year. As their reward, they enjoyed pizza and film afternoon.
