The news that we have been waiting for has finally arrived. The new Mayfield School will be ready at the end of November 2018.

Therefore the arrangements for the pupils will be to move in **after** the Christmas holidays. Prior to this, there will be opportunities to visit the school and support the pupils with the transition.

Autumn Term 2018

Pupils will start the new academic year in our current building on Monday 3rd September 2018
The end of the autumn term - Tuesday 18th December 2018.

(Staff INSET days will be Wednesday 19th, Thursday 20th and Friday 21st December 2018)

Spring Term 2019

(Staff INSET days - Thursday 3rd, Friday 4th January 2019.)

Staff will move into the new school on Monday 7th January 2019

Pupils will move in on Tuesday 8th January 2019.

The end of the spring term being Friday 29th March 2019.

Summer Term 2019

Pupils will return into the new school on Monday 15th April 2019 with the end of the summer term being Friday 19th July 2019

Bank Holidays - Good Friday - 19th April and Easter Monday 22nd April 2019 and Monday 6th May 2019

Uniform proposal - Uniform is NOT compulsory for pupils at Mayfield School. In January 2019 we will launch our new uniform and logo for the new school. The colour throughout the school will be purple.

Grey and white will also be available for basic clothing.

Options with logo - grey / purple polo shirt, cardigan, sweatshirt & PE shirt

Tartan skirt - upto age 13

Grey trousers or skirt.

For pupils in Mountains Department - optional Grey Blazer (with logo) and Tartan fashion clip tie to be worn with white shirt.

Additionally, Tartan neckerchiefs and hair scrunches' will be available.

I will provide further details of suppliers and costs in the new autumn term.

I appreciate that for some pupils, changes will be difficult. To help transition, if you wished to do so plain purple / grey polo shirts could be purchased for September.
