What an incredible year it has been for the Friends of South Cave School, our Parent Teacher Association. We started the year struggling for support, which led to us almost stopping altogether. We gave it one last push in January when over 35 parents and teachers came along to show their support - so we continued, and what a journey it has been.

Since January, we've been working hard to deliver multiple events and activities, which has meant various meetings, organisation and a lot of hard work. But it was worth it because we raised a whopping **£11,871!** Taking our total funds to **£15,147.** We're delighted and so grateful to everyone who helped us achieve this - organising events, buying a disco ticket, putting 20ps into a Smartie's tube or attending meetings. No matter what your contribution, together we've raised this money to further enrich the lives of all our children (see page 2 for how we're spending the money).

On behalf of the Friends of South Cave School and all the children, THANK YOU for helping us. We'll be back in September with more events and initiatives, we look forward to seeing you then.

## Spending the funds raised by Friends

This year we've been raising funds to purchase new IT equipment, to give our children greater access to tablet computers. After the rocky start at the beginning of the year we weren't sure how much we'd raise or how many we'd be able to buy, but with what we've achieved, we've been able to purchase 18 new tablets to be shared out across the school.

Working closely with the teaching staff and with the advice of IT advisors, we were asked to buy iPads/Google Chrome Books for the children to use across the year groups. With the money raised, we've been able to buy five sets of six devices - 30 in total. After a lot of research, we've decided to purchase the equipment through the school's IT provider, who supply the equipment with software fully installed and support available after purchase. The new equipment has been ordered and will be ready for the children to use next term.

This has exceeded our expectations and goes to show that when we all work together, we really can achieve great things. At our AGM in October we'll be deciding what to raise funds for in 2018/19. We'd love to hear your views so please come along or get in touch.

Thank you again for all your support in helping us to achieve this.
