In phonics this week the children have been learning to recognise CVCC and CCVC words. They have been learning to recognise and write words remembering to include each letter they hear carefully.

In maths this week the children have continued to secure their knowledge of 3D shapes. They have been learning to name them and describe them using the vocabulary faces, edges and vertices. You might like to continue supporting them with this at home by going on a 3D shape hunt around your house.
