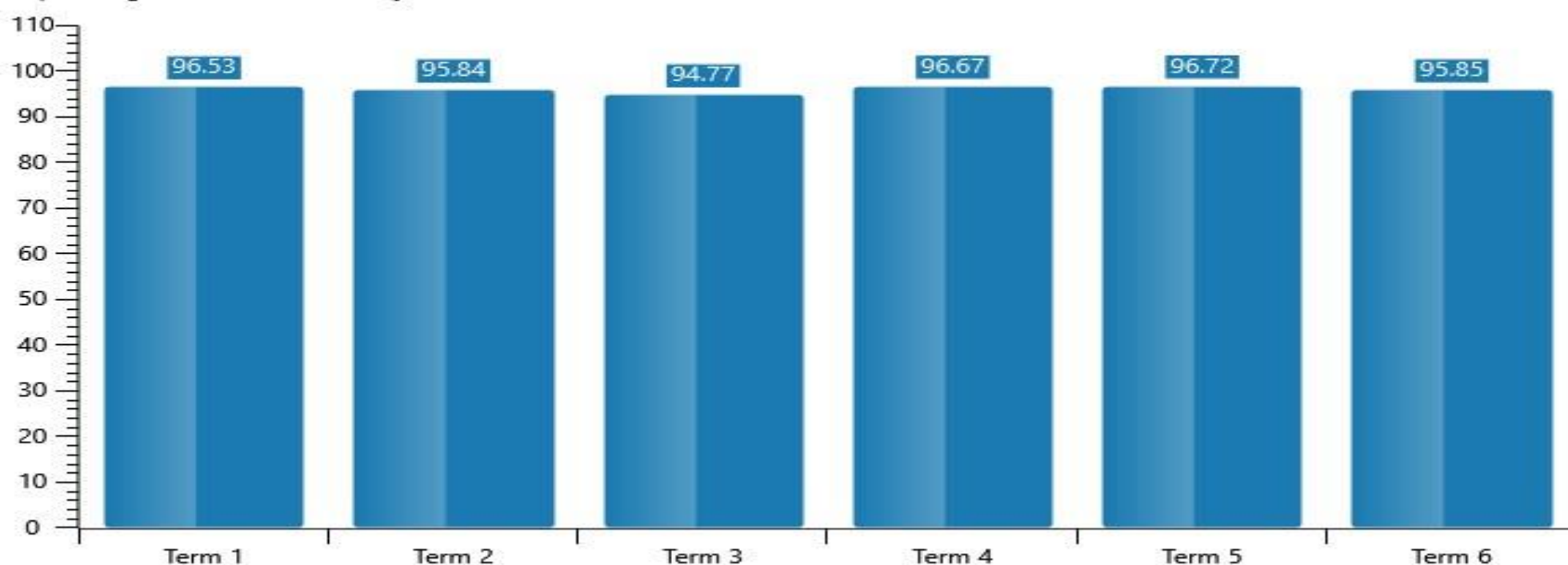
Goodbyes
