

ENGLISH

Through our topic work, we will have opportunities to write descriptive sentences and narratives, design comic strips, write fact files and provide labels and captions.

Children will be able to use speech and add this to their own comic strip!

We will read Charlie's Superhero Underpants and then imagine how an everyday hero could develop their own super power. Children will then write a fantasy story to be carried out by their new superhero!

MATHS

In our maths lessons we will be exploring number and place value by counting and estimating, recognising arrays, exploring our number bonds, doubling numbers and recognising shapes and their properties.

SCIENCE

We will be developing our understanding of humans by discussing the human body and identifying, naming, drawing and labelling the basic body parts and saying which part of the body is associated with each sense.

We will also find out who in the class has Superhero skills and how our senses rely upon each other to make us super!
