

## ENGLISH

Through our topic work we will have opportunities to plan and write recounts about a memorable learning experience and also about our local area. We will use labels and captions to compare past and present features of towns and to identify key aspects relating to the Queens life. Our topic book will focus on "This is London" by Miroslav Sasek

## MATHS

This term we will be looking at Number and Place Value, comparing and ordering numbers. WE will be revising number bonds as well as describing position and direction using common words. We will develop our mental addition and subtraction skills by counting on and recognising coins and values, beginning to make amounts in pence.

## SCIENCE

We will look at building materials and sort them into natural and man-made materials, thinking what properties would be suitable for walls, windows, doors roofs. WE will also look at what buildings were made of in 1666, what their properties were and why. Children will also discover which plants can be found in the locality and how they are looked after in our community.

## PE

We will be developing our Gymnastics skills of balance, movement and rolls, being able to link movements together to create sequences.

## RE

In this half term we will be looking at why Christmas matters to Christians, why they celebrate it and how.

## COMPUTING

We will use technology purposefully to create, organise, store, manipulate and retrieve digital data by visiting the official website of the monarchy and taking a virtual tour of Buckingham Palace. Children will also use a suitable image editing software programme to insert themselves into a royal photograph.

## HISTORY

We will explore changes within living memory; significant People, Places and Events in the local area. Children will also learn about the Great Fire of London, imagining that they are Thomas Farriner's assistant in Pudding Lane. Instructions will be produced for how to make bread.

Children will look at the work of a variety of artists who draw urban landscapes of their locality.

## PSHE

We will explore belonging to a Community, Improving the Local area, and how we can be active citizens.

## GEOGRAPHY

We shall be identifying the countries that make up the United Kingdom, looking at the seas around it, the significant flags and the Capital Cities. Children will also have the opportunity to spot recognisable features and landmarks in the local area.
