Your child has been taking part in instrumental music lessons at Our Lady and All Saints primary school over the past two years and you may be considering the options for continuation next year when they move to High School.

Hopefully your child has enjoyed the experience of playing an instrument which has not only given them an insight into instrumental music but has helped with other aspects of their educational development.

Whole Class Tuition at primary school can be the beginning of a lifelong skill to be enjoyed in later life and show colleges or universities and prospective employers of a richness of experience.

If your child wishes to continue having tuition in Year 7 there are several options available.

If your child is going to St Bedes High School lessons are available on PDP (Parental Direct Payment). If sufficient pupils register these will be available in small groups or individual lessons. Pupils moving to other high schools may offer lessons. please contact me directly and I will investigate this on your behalf.

Ormskirk Music Centre offers tuition on all instruments from professional, experienced teachers who work for Lancashire Music Service and takes place at Ormskirk School on Wednesdays 4:00-7:00pm

Students can also take part in a range of ensembles giving them the opportunity to perform in concerts with other pupils.

The ensembles follow a recognized pathway for students into the Lancashire Music Service County Ensembles, performing nationally to a high standard.

Pupils who wish to continue playing a brass instrument, but chose not to have lessons in school will still be welcome at the "Blow it!" ensemble Wednesday's 5.00-6:00pm

At the end of the year their instrument will be passed on to the next cohort of children in school. Instruments are available to hire from the Music Service at a reasonable charge, endangered instruments are available on free loan.
