Pupil Premium Report July 2017

Children eligible for pupil premium receive extra government funding (Early Years Pupil Premium EYPP). During 2016-17 we used this funding to provide staffing and resources for extra focus groups which included: collaborative physical play; language enrichment; creativity and language development and mathematical skills and problem solving.

1. **Collaborative physical play group** – for those pupil premium children whose greatest need is the Personal Social and Emotional development identified by the EYFS assessment and general observations during play.

Aim of the project to increase opportunities for supported social communication play and self-confidence to take risks and developing turn taking skills.

Resources purchased: Plum Premium Wooden See Saw, giant spinning top and dedicated adult time:

2. **Language enrichment group** – for those pupil premium children whose greatest need is their communication and language development identified by their EYFS assessment.

Aim of the project: to use the children's interests in technology resources and music to motivate them to verbally communicate with other children and adults and support their language development skills. To produce a resource that can be used at home, so that parents are also involved in supporting their child's language development.

Resources purchased: Easy speak microphone set, easy speak sound station, recordable CDs and dedicated adult time.

Total cost £252

3. **Mathematical skills and problem-solving group** – for those EY pupil premium children whose EYFS assessments show they are meeting age related expectations in all curriculum areas but need more challenge in Maths to make further progress.

Aim of the project: to use children's interests in outdoor and water play to develop their problem solving and mathematical skills. Children will be shown the equipment and will need to work out how to fit the different shapes together to make a water trail.

Resources purchased: Water world set and water world accessory set and dedicated adult time.

4. **Developing creativity using music** – for those EY pupil premium children whose needs include developing their listening and concentration skills identified by their EYFS assessment.

Aim of the project: to use the children’s interest in musical instruments to motivate them to listen to and follow instructions within a small group. To develop their skill in keeping a beat and rhythm to further develop their concentration.

Resources purchased: Music Express Early Years Foundation Stage; music starter set; claves 8 pack and dedicated adult time.
