



Wood End School Equality Objectives

Report to Governors on Equality Objectives – Summer Term 2018

Objective 1

To ensure that disadvantaged pupils achieve challenging targets and the gaps in attainment for these pupils are reduced. Pupils to make at least expected progress.

Comment:

As of June 2018, we have a combined total of 9 pupils who are either CLA, Pupil Premium or Ever 6. The Standards Committee have had termly updates on the progress of these children. We ensure various interventions are in place to meet their needs and extend their learning. The children have been assessed as being either broadly in line within age related expectations or above. Therefore these pupils continue to achieve their challenging targets. The SLT continue to monitor the progress of these pupils in line with our pupil progress meetings.

Objective 2

To ensure consistent reporting and recording of racist and bullying incidents throughout the school.

Comment:

Any perceived incidents are dealt with swiftly by staff. Incidents are reported to the headteacher and they are recorded. They are also reported to the Governors via the termly heads report.

Objective 3

To ensure a range of people come into school e.g. for assemblies to talk to the children about different cultures/religions.

Comment:

In the last two years we have had numerous people from a variety of different cultures and religions either present in assembly; talk to year groups as part of their topic. The PTA have provided funding to support this as we aim to raise the profile of different religions/ethnicities.
