### Abacus After School Club

#### Introduction

Welcome to Abacus After School club. Abacus is owned by Sharon Williams and Kayley Harrington. It has been an established company in Havering since 2004 and we are registered with Ofsted and Early Years. Our existing provisions have been graded GOOD and OUTSTANDING by Ofsted. Abacus is available to all Infant and Junior School children. We aim to provide a caring, safe environment for your child through individual attention and group activities. We like to encourage a child to play socially, with respect, kindness and consideration for others. Abacus offers a service equal to every child, regardless of age, culture or need.

### **Times of opening**

We are open Monday to Friday after school until 6.00pm. This is term time only and does not include the school inset days.

### **Staff**

All staff have the relevant qualifications and checks required by Ofsted. The owners have had Safer Recruitment training. This is a recommendation from the Independent Safeguarding Authority. There will always be a First Aider on site. Staff members have a sound understanding of the Early Years Foundation Stage and will continue to update their training.

### **Activities**

**Indoor include-**Arts and craft, quiet area, book table, homework, TV, Playstation, board games, small world toys, four in a row, pool table, playdough, construction, cold cooking, movie night and ICT.

**Outdoor include-**Team games, football, skipping ropes, Hopscotch, Rounders, Badminton, Individual toys.

### **Food**

We have a rolling drinks bar at the After School Club. The children are offered a healthy snack every night. These include wraps, sandwiches, beans on toast and there is always a selection of fruit or vegetables. Meal times are a time for staff and children to sit together and discuss their day, also their thoughts on how their club is running. All children's dietary requirements are taken into account and an alternative is always available. A menu will be on display for parents to see.

### **Breakfast Club**

At the Breakfast Club we have a variety of table top games, allowing the children to start the school day in a calm environment. We open from 7.45am until the start of the school day, term time only. We offer a choice of cereals, toast with toppings, crumpets, muffins, fruit, yogurts and a rolling drinks bar. Once you have registered your child then you can use the breakfast club as and when required. This may be daily or one off. We can help for doctors appointments or an early start to the shops.
