Royal blue sweatshirt or cardigan, with logo	All	Strongly preferred
Plain white polo shirt	All	Compulsory NB Logo polo shirt available, but not preferred/expected
Dark grey trousers, skirt, pinafore, culottes, shorts – traditional, appropriate school wear only	All Reception – please see option below	Compulsory Leggings are not allowed other than for PE
Black school shoes – trainers are not allowed, although plain black trainer style shoes are (no logos or writing). Heeled shoes are not permitted.	All	Compulsory  Sensible black ankle boots may be worn in winter months.
Blue gingham summer dress	All	Optional – may be worn during Sept or October, and on warm Spring & Summer days
Dark grey or blue tights or white or grey socks	All	Compulsory
Royal blue sunhat	All	Compulsory for summer months
Black or navy jogging bottoms	Reception	Preferred
Royal blue bookbag, with logo	YR-4	Strongly preferred
Royal blue backpack, with logo	Y5 & 6	Optional Only logoed backpacks are allowed. If no backpack is used, then a book bag must be used as above
Water bottle	All	Compulsory
Old adult shirt for art overall	All	Preferred
Pencil case	Y5 & 6	Optional
Jewellery – only 1x pair stud earrings and one watch may be worn. Earrings MUST be taken out for PE by the child.	All	Our preference is for no earrings to be worn in school.
Mobile phone	Y6 only	Optional, and only with agreement of school
Bike helmet	All	Compulsory for all children who ride bikes. Preferred for scooter riders
Lunchbox	All	Compulsory for any child choosing packed lunches
Wellington boots or appropriate outdoor footwear	All	Compulsory for any child wanting to play on field in winter months Wellington boots preferred for all Reception children

Sensible school coat	All	Compulsory Optional school coats with logo may be bought from Mapac
Royal blue PE top, with logo	Y1-6	Strongly preferred
Black PE shorts or skort	Y1-6	Compulsory
Black jogging bottoms or leggings for winter PE	Y1-6	Optional
PE fleece	Y1-6	Optional
Trainers	Y1-6	Optional
White socks for PE	Y1-4	Compulsory
Long black PE socks	Y 5 & 6	Optional
Shinpads	Y5 & 6	Preferred
Football boots, bootbag	Y5 & 6	Preferred for outdoor sports
Royal blue PE bag, with logo	Y1-4	Preferred Y5 & 6 may use backpack for PE kit; if no backpack is used, a PE bag must be used. No plastic carrier bags for PE kit, please

**PLEASE NAME EVERYTHING, INCLUDING WATER BOTTLES, COATS, SOCKS, UNDERWEAR!**

To avoid confusion:

Shoes must be black – no heels, fashion shoes, boots, trainers, sandals or flip-flops.

Plain royal blue sweatshirts or cardigans may be worn. No “hoodies”, sports jumpers, cardigans, tops or items with large lettering or logos should be worn.

Please note children **will not** need plimsolls.

P.E kit will be left in school.

Please note children are not to wear jewellery for P.E lessons – if they have studs they must either remove them for P.E. or use tape to cover them (tape must be provided from home).

Long hair must be tied back; accessories should be royal blue or hair colour, and of minimal size; extreme hairstyles not allowed - No tramlines or patterns should be shaved into the hair or the eyebrows, hair should be naturally coloured (no hair dye).

Smart watches may be worn but must be in airplane mode only at all times on school site  
Mobile phones are only permitted for Y6 pupils, and must be handed into the school office daily.

Nail varnish is not allowed.

We would advise that all valuable items and/or those of sentimental value be left at home to avoid loss or damage.
