Year 5/6 Trip: Sewerby Hall & Gardens

Dear Parents/Carers,

I am writing to inform you of an exciting school trip which we have organised as part of our whole school World War One topic, 'Where The Poppies Now Grow'. All children from Year 2 to Year 6 will be visiting Sewerby Hall and Gardens to travel back in time to the Edwardian era. **Wednesday 12th September** will be **Year 5/6's** turn and they will attend the education facility for the day leaving school at **9:15 am** and returning back to school at **3:15 pm**. To keep in with the theme of our school trip we would like children to dress in their **Edwardian clothes** which they will be wearing for our topic launch day (tomorrow!)

During the visit the children will carry out a range of activities both in the house and grounds. This will include learning about Edwardian life, exploring Edwardian artefacts and taking part in Edwardian role play. The children will immerse themselves in the Edwardian era and will have the opportunity to perform daily chores, make WW1 ANZAC biscuits and discover Sewerby Hall. They will also visit the WW1 exhibition and look closely at artefacts. All activities will be delivered by Sewerby Hall's Education team who will also be acting in character for the day.

We are asking for voluntary contributions of **£5.00** towards the cost of the trip. **This trip will not go ahead if insufficient monies are received.** Our aim is to provide a quality experience for the children at a highly regarded educational environment with activities led by the education team and feel this contribution is a fair price. There is no need for the children to bring money with them on the day.

School packed lunches will be available at a cost of **£2.30**. These consist of: a cheese sandwich on white bread or a ham sandwich on brown bread, carrot sticks, a biscuit, a piece of fruit and a bottle of water. Please indicate on the reply slip below if your child will be having a school packed lunch and which sandwich option they would prefer. If you are entitled to claim free school meals, a packed lunch can be request if you wish. If you are providing your own packed lunch, please bring plastic bottles or cartons (no glass bottles please.)

Please return the consent form overleaf and money to your child's class teacher no later than **Friday 7th September**.
