



Uniform Policy

'This school is committed to safeguarding and promoting the wellbeing of all children, and expects our staff and volunteers to share this commitment'.

This policy is intended to be read by parents of children at Stirchley Primary School. Uniform is compulsory at Stirchley Primary School. We believe that wearing uniform promotes a sense of belonging and unity. Parents have expressed support for a whole school uniform policy and agree with the school that wearing the uniform helps to maintain our calm school approach.

Dress code

- Grey trousers or skirt.
- Grey pinafore dress.
- White shirt, blouse or Polo shirt.
- Royal blue jumper /cardigan with school logo
- Black shoes/ trainers. (material style boots are not permitted in school, as they become water logged)
- Headscarf (Muslim girls). Scarves covering the face will not be permitted

Summer uniform variations

- Blue/white summer dress
- Grey shorts

PE

- Grey Shorts and White T-shirt
- Black pumps
- One piece swimming costume (KS2)
- Swimming trunks – not long legged shorts (KS2)
- Tracksuit, trainers for outdoor PE in winter

The school stocks a range of uniform items such as:

School Jumpers, Polo Shirts, Cardigans and book bags these can be obtained from the school office

Jewellery

A small pair of stud earrings and a watch are the only acceptable items of jewellery.

Hair

Long hair must be tied back for PE lessons. Mohicans, coloured extensions, dyed hair and patterned hair will not be permitted. These fashion hair styles should be kept for school holidays.

Makeup

Makeup is not permitted.
