YOUNG VOICES (YV) CONCERT - JANUARY 2019

On **Thursday 31st January 2019**, the 'Young Voices' concert will take place at the O2 Arena in London. I am excited to inform you that Westende Junior School pupils have the opportunity to take part in this large-scale production. We are offering the concert to **UPPER SCHOOL (YR5/6)** pupils. We have participated in this concert for several years now. It is a fantastic opportunity for the children and they have always really enjoyed themselves in the past.

Before making a decision, please be aware that there may be some costs involved. The children are required to wear either a YV t-shirt for the concert (priced at £10 each) or alternatively their own plain white t-shirt. In addition, tickets for parents/relatives can also be purchased (**priced at £22 per ticket**) although this is not compulsory. There will also be a fee for the coach to and from the O2 (price to be confirmed).

Please note that due to large numbers of children and families exiting the O2 after the concert, parents/guardians will be unable to collect their children from the O2. The children will return to school on the coach with staff as the children's safety is our priority.

Ideally, we would like all year 5 and 6 pupils to take part in the YV concert as it is such a fantastic opportunity!

To order tickets, please complete **the ticket order form** section and return by **Monday 17th September 2018** latest.

Please note final numbers cannot be changed after these dates as YV have a strict deadline
