Create a poster or advert that persuades people to buy the product. Remember to show the reader or viewer how amazing the item is.</p>	<p><b><u>A postcard from India.</u></b></p> <p>Imagine you are on holiday in India. Design a postcard that shows where you are and write about your holiday on the back. Think about the places you may have been, the food you may have eaten, the people you have met and the things you have done.</p>	<p>For those who like to write poetry.</p> <p><b><u>The amazing sights and smells of India</u></b></p> <p>Create a selection of poems that describe the colours, sights and smells of India. Use pictures in books, and on the internet to inspire you, as well as smelling Indian spices and food.</p>
<p>Prefer facts?</p> <p><b><u>A mini guide to India</u></b></p> <p>Research the tourist features of India. Use your new knowledge to create a leaflet, poster or powerpoint guide for tourists to use.
