MATHS

Number: Place Value

Read, write, order and compare numbers up to 10 000 000 and determine the value of each digit.

Round any whole number to a required degree of accuracy.

Use negative numbers in context, and calculate intervals across zero.

Number: Addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

Solve addition and subtraction multi step problems in contexts, deciding which operations and methods to use and why. Multiply multi-digit number up to 4 digits by a 2 digit number using the formal written method of long multiplication. Divide numbers up to 4 digits by a 2 digit whole number using the formal written method of long division.

Perform mental calculations, including with mixed operations and large numbers.
