



English

We will be basing our learning around a text and a film this term.

The Sheep-pig and Tiny Knight.

A variety of genres will be completed in connection with the novel and film: newspaper reports, narrative writing, emails, diary entry and letter.

We will have a big focus on grammar and spelling also.



Science

We will be learning about what rocks tell us about the way the Earth was formed. We will look at rocks/fossils and what we can learn from them. We will also be learning about the movement of objects.



PSHCE/SRE

This will include developing knowledge of physical/mental health and well-being.



Maths

We will be learning to:

Read and write numbers in numerals and words up to 1000

Compare and order numbers to 1000

Count in multiples of 2,5,10, 50, 100

Add and subtract numbers up to 1000 mentally

Recall and use multiplication and division facts

Solve problems using various methods

Measure, compare, add & subtract lengths

Measure the perimeter of 2D shapes



PE

We will be focusing on gymnastics and dance. The children will learn how to move to a rhythm and create their own dance. The gymnastics lessons will focus on flexibility and building sequences.



Music

We will be developing ideas about what music animals would dance to if they were on 'strictly come dancing'. Learning to play the ukulele.

Autumn

Term

Year 3



RE

We will be learning about the Christian faith through the study of the symbols and beliefs. We will also learn about the importance of Advent to Christians.



Art

We will be questioning whether we could be illustrators for a best selling children's book.



Computing

We will be studying e-safety and how programming works. Computing skills including word processing, internet research and data handling will be taught cross curricular.



DT

We will be working on building a structure that can bridge a gap. The children will need to consider the size of the gap, what is under the gap, the most appropriate materials to use and the strongest structure.



History

We will be learning about who lived in Britain first. The children will compare different periods of time to identify changes. We will be studying way of life, transport, shelter, hunting and cooking.

Homework/Spelling

Spellings and homework will be handed out every Friday. Homework is to be returned by a Tuesday. Spellings will be given out on a Friday



Geography

We will be studying a topic called what makes the Earth angry? In this we will be looking at natural disasters and extreme weather conditions. We will focus mainly on storms, volcanoes, tsunamis etc.
