External visits show the children have a growing understanding of how to keep themselves healthy and what constitutes a healthy lifestyle. Pupil voice shows that most children understand what makes a healthy meal and which foods they should avoid having in greater quantity. The % of children attending a physical club continues to climb. This now needs to be targeted at those children who are known to be unfit and do not attend any physical activity at lunchtime or after school. Teachers continue to report the benefit of experiencing lessons taught by a specialist. The specialist is also monitored for quality assurance by his own company.

To use the coaches to prepare children to compete in inter school competitions	£1000	To increase children's participation in inter sports contests from 3 activities to 6 activities	Inter school contests continued to grow and a number were attended by children throughout the school. The children's success at the competitions improved over the course of last year. A very successful SEN competition was attended by children.
