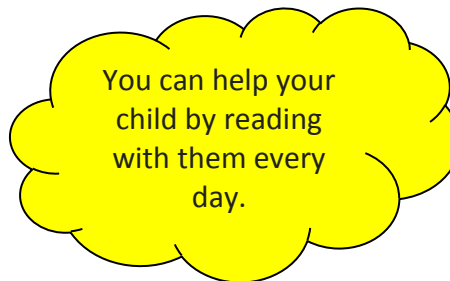




English >>>

The children will continue to develop their phonic skills through games and group activities. We are going to revise and build on the skills taught in Reception. Our English work will be based on the text, 'What the Ladybird Heard' by Julia Donaldson and will also be linked to our Geography topic, 'On the Farm'.

Mathematics >>>

In Maths this half term, we will be learning lots about Number! We will be counting in different ways whilst completing lots of fun Maths' challenges. As we become more confident with counting up to 10 and 20 we will use this knowledge to help us to add and subtract one digit numbers.

Religious Education >>>

Our R.E topic for this half term is 'Families'. The children will learn about how everyone belongs to the family of God.

They will begin to understand:

- The love and care shown in the family
- About God's love and care for every family

Geography >>>

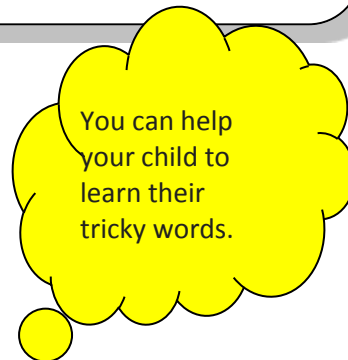
This term our Geography topic is 'At the Farm'. We will be looking at different types of farms, how farms are affected by the different seasons and the role of animals on a farm.

Science

This term the children will be looking at Animals including Humans. Children will have the opportunity to use their 5 senses by carrying out simple experiments. We will also be labelling parts of the human body. We will be looking at Animals and the different categories they belong to.

Physical Education >>>

This term in P.E, the children will develop & enhance their skills in Gymnastics and Dance. P.E is on a Tuesday. Please ensure that your child's P.E kit is in school at all times.

Phonics >>>

The children will receive daily differentiated Phonic sessions using the Letters & Sounds Six –Phase Teaching Programme which commenced in Nursery.

Computing >>>

Our topic for Computing this half term is about Online Safety. The children will:

- know how to use technology safely and respectfully.
- Know the features of a strong password
- Know what is personal information
- Know where to go for help.

Art >>>

Our Art topic this term is 'Colour Creations'. They will find out about primary colours and how to mix them to create secondary colours, as well as looking at the artwork of artists who use colours in interesting ways.

The theme for this half term's music lessons will be, 'Sounds interesting – Exploring sounds'.
