**Several responses were linked to:**

- Staff being approachable
- Strong communication with parents/carers
- Lots of opportunities and extra-curricular opportunities for the children
- Focus on the development of the whole child
- Wide range of clubs
- Breakfast Club
- Rewarding good behaviour
- Dealing with issues of bullying straight away
- School having a friendly and supportive feel to it
- The school being well managed and the teachers organised
- The school caring about the 'whole child', not just the academic side

- STEAM afternoons
- School being very much a part of the community
- Enthusiastic and committed staff
- Variation in subjects – not all academic
- The school embraces children and encourages them to develop and enjoy learning
- As well as great teaching the staff really care

**In your opinion how could the school develop further?**

**Several responses were linked to:**

- More sports being available to KS1 children
- More advanced notice of upcoming days/events/trips/items needed for school
- Further use of the outdoor facilities
- School providing a general After School Club
- Continued choice of after school clubs involving KS1 more
- School continuing to work with the local community/events
- School focussing on the lunch hour, to develop social skills further and friendly behaviour
- Homework being too heavily weighted with English tasks

We have not included **all** of the responses, whether they were positive or areas for improvement. We have identified areas that have been highlighted several times as our initial main areas to focus on and communicate with you. However, all feedback is important to us and valued, even if it is just the opinion of one parent/carer. All feedback has been shared with staff in school and the relevant staff members and the staff team will be working on addressing any areas that have been brought to our attention. Over the coming academic year we endeavour to make changes in light of your views and feedback and we will keep you updated as we do so. As mentioned in the newsletter, home learning is an area we have tweaked in light of your responses and we are certain that the small changes will make a difference to home learning expectations. As always please let us know your thoughts, views and suggestions as and when they arise. We are always open to feedback of any kind.
