#### National targets are;

The floor standard from 2016:

- at least 65% of pupils meet the expected standard in English reading, English writing and Mathematics [Please note that only 22.8% of schools attained 65% or better in 2016!] or
- the school achieves sufficient progress scores in all three subjects. At least -5 in English reading, -5 in mathematics and -7 in English writing.

To be above the floor, the school needs to meet either the attainment **or** all of the progress element. We do not yet know what this floor standard is for 2017.

The 'Coasting' definition in 2016;

- fewer than 85% of pupils achieved the expected standard at the end of primary schools [Please note that only 3.07% of schools attained 85% or better in 2016!] and average progress made by pupils is less than -2.5 in English reading, -2.5 in mathematics or -3.5 in English writing
- A school will have to be below the relevant coasting threshold in all three years to fall within the overall coasting definition. (There were also coasting definitions for 2014 and 2015). We do not yet know what this definition is for 2017.

Takeley is **above** both the floor standard and 'coasting' threshold because progress data is better than the minimum measures.
