


## **Autumn 1 – Homework Booklet**

Dear Parents/Carers,

This is your child's Mission Possible Homework Booklet for **Autumn 1**. The home learning activities are linked to the Mission we are focussing on, and have been carefully chosen to develop different skills in relation to a variety of curriculum subjects.

The children are able to choose the order in which they wish to complete the activities. It is hoped that this will encourage the children to organise their time and to plan in advance, so they can gather relevant materials to complete the art/design-based tasks. There may be more home learning activities than the number of weeks in this half term. However, it is hoped that this will allow the children to make independent choices about which tasks they would like to undertake.

If your child brings in a piece of work chosen from the tasks detailed in this Homework Booklet by the **Friday** of each week, they will receive a merit. Children are able to 'earn' merits for a number of reasons throughout the school year. Merits add up, and can be cashed in for prizes.
