SCHOOL MEALS

The total cost of school meals for the first half of the Autumn Term will be £71.30 (31days x £2.30).

Please be aware children moving into Key Stage 2 (from Year 2 into Year 3) will no longer be entitled to universal infant free school meals. Whilst payment can be made on a daily basis it is helpful if dinners are paid weekly or half termly in advance. Money should be handed in at the front office or to the Class Teacher in a sealed, named envelope. Cheques should be payable to SCC Hundon CP School.

Please note on Thursday there will be a special menu for "Roald Dahl" day. The menu is attached at the end of the newsletter. This will mean that TUESDAY lunch will be ROAST DINNER.

Breakfast and After-School Clubs

As previously shared unfortunately Prestige Sports are no longer able to provide the Breakfast Club we offered on a Tuesday morning, however, we are pleased to be offering Breakfast Clubs on Wednesdays and Thursdays and extending this offer to include Fridays from 8.00am as well. All ages are welcome for these clubs. The theme of these clubs will be Sports Mania with Laser Tag on Fridays. These clubs will be financed through the PE and Sport Premium Funding allocation made to the school by the Department of Education. These clubs will start this week, with the first session being on Wednesday 12th September.

Additionally, using the same funding we are increasing our after-school PE and Sport club offer with clubs on Mondays and Thursdays from 3.15pm until 4.15pm. Our Monday Club will be football-focused and is offered for pupils in Years 3 through to Year 6 and starts on Monday 17th September. Our Thursday Club will

be a Dodgeball Club for this half-term and again is offered for pupils in Years 3 to Year 6. This club will commence on Thursday 18th September.

The after school clubs will be offered on a first come first served basis by signing a consent form available from the School Office.
