Welcome Back



Can we please kindly ask for any payments that are made to school to be put in **sealed, named** envelopes. The office is extremely busy at the start and end of school and money presented to them without envelopes can cause un-necessary queues to build up in the main entrance.

There has been an increase to school meals from 3rd September, the cost is £2.35 per day (£11.75 per 5 day week).

Can we also please reiterate that change can no longer be sent home. Any monies paid over the amount due will be carried over to the following week.
