

<p style="text-align: center;"><u>RE</u></p> <p>In RE, Year 1 will be learning about ‘God’s Great Plan’. The children will become aware of the beauty of God’s world and explore and respond to the wonders of his creation. They will learn and discuss the meanings of many stories such as the Creation story and Noah and the Flood through listening and role playing. They will begin their topic by learning about the role of a monarch and move on to discovering who the fiercest King or Queen of England was. We will be making links with English through making family tree’s or our own as well as labelling the different parts of a castle. By the end of our topic the children will be able to tell you the fiercest King or Queen of England as well as being able to tell you lots about their roles.</p> <p>We will be making links with our ‘Everyday materials’ topic in science where the children will be able to use their learning about the properties of materials to experiment with the perfect materials to make a crown.</p>

Year 1 –Autumn term.</i></p>	<div style="text-align: center;">  <p><i>Together we are exploring our special gifts; Together we are growing towards God.</i></p> </div>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Foundation Subjects</u></p> <p>In PE we will begin our topic of Athletics where we will be working to improve our skills of throwing and catching as well as learning to move in a variety of different ways including skipping, running and jumping.</p> <p>In ICT we will start our learning on the chrome books, this half term the children will be learning about the different aspects of a chrome book, how to use them safely as well as logging on independently. Once this skill has been mastered the children will move onto word processing and typing on a chrome book.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Maths</u></p> <p>The children will be understanding place value up to 10 and 20 using different model and images. We will be writing captions to go with images as well as labelling these different images in a variety of topics. We will also be learning how to write instructions through the use of Talk for Writing. The children will learn a set of instructions in which they will then innovate and add their own ideas. Our class text will be “How to trap a dragon” and I can’t wait to hear and read all of the children’s new ideas.</p> <p>Guided Reading will take place in class on a Friday morning and the children will have chance to access new texts and deepen their knowledge of what they have read through questioning from an adult.</p>
