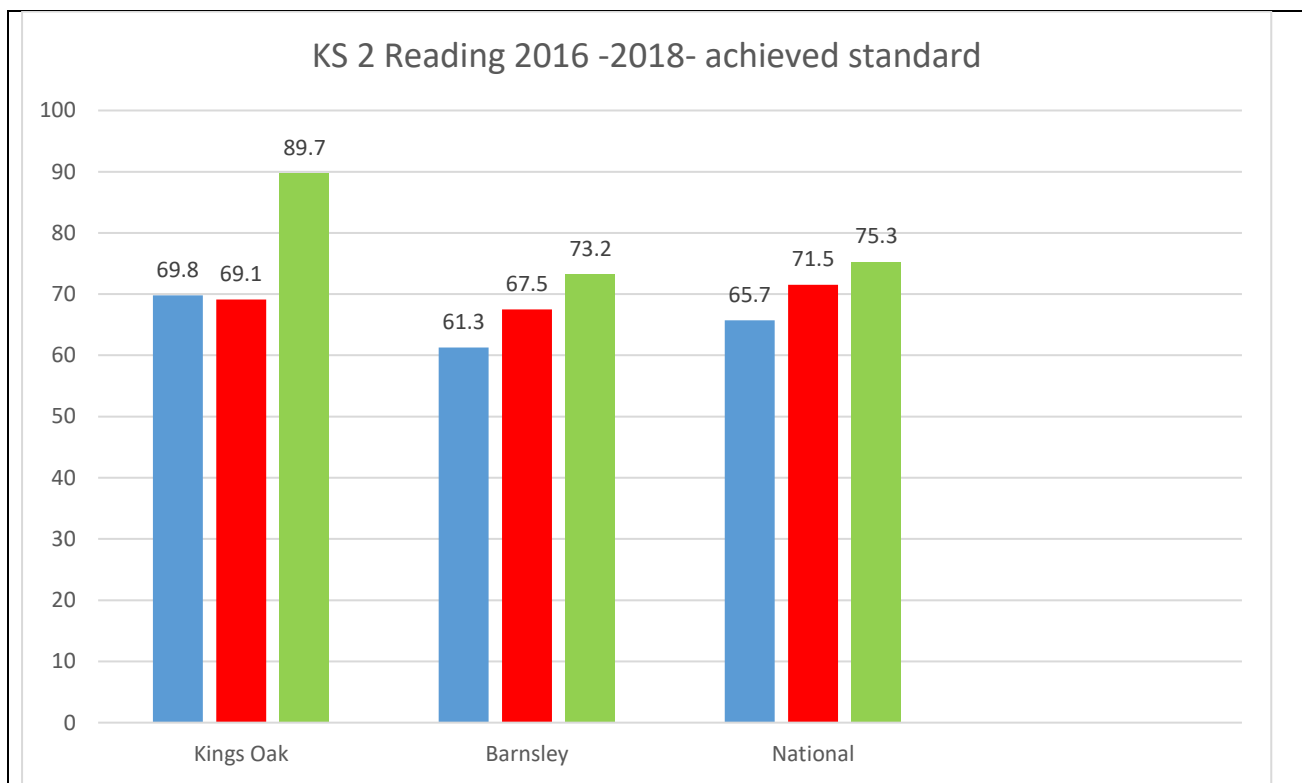
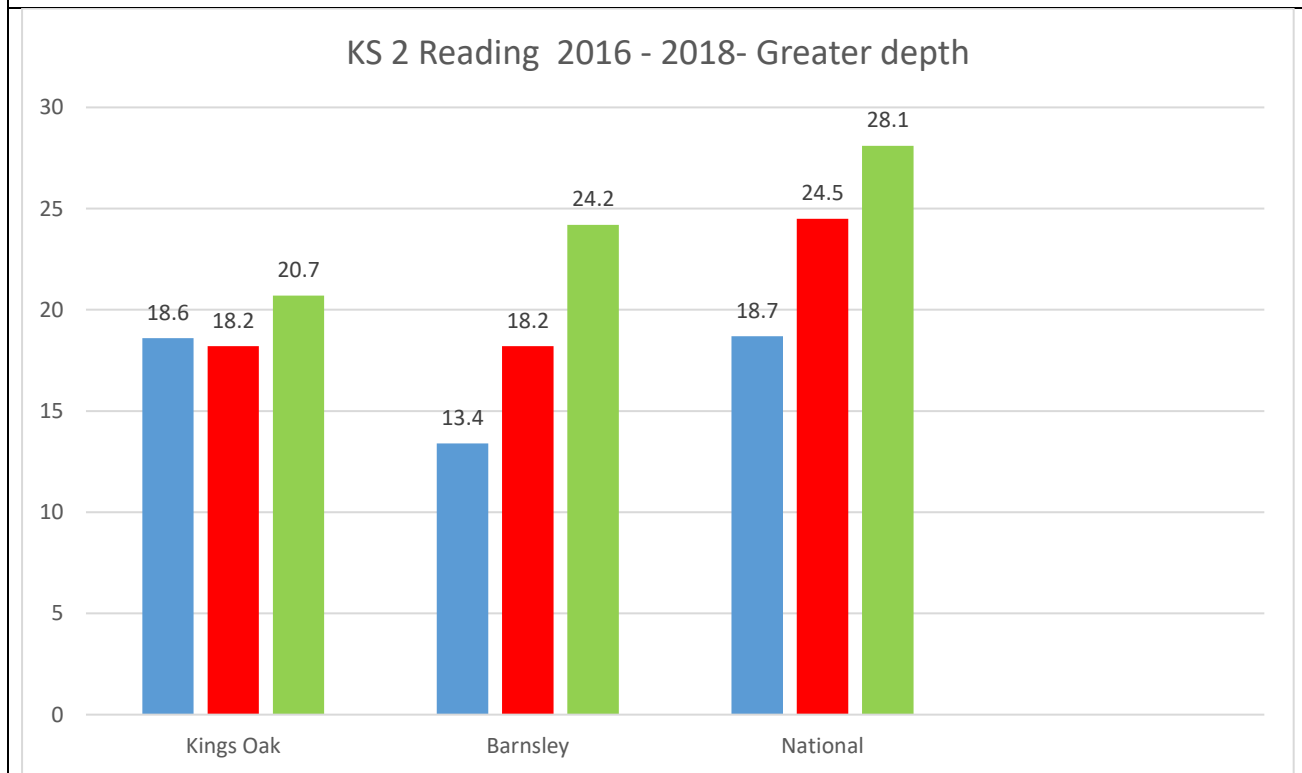


Key Stage 2 Results 2018

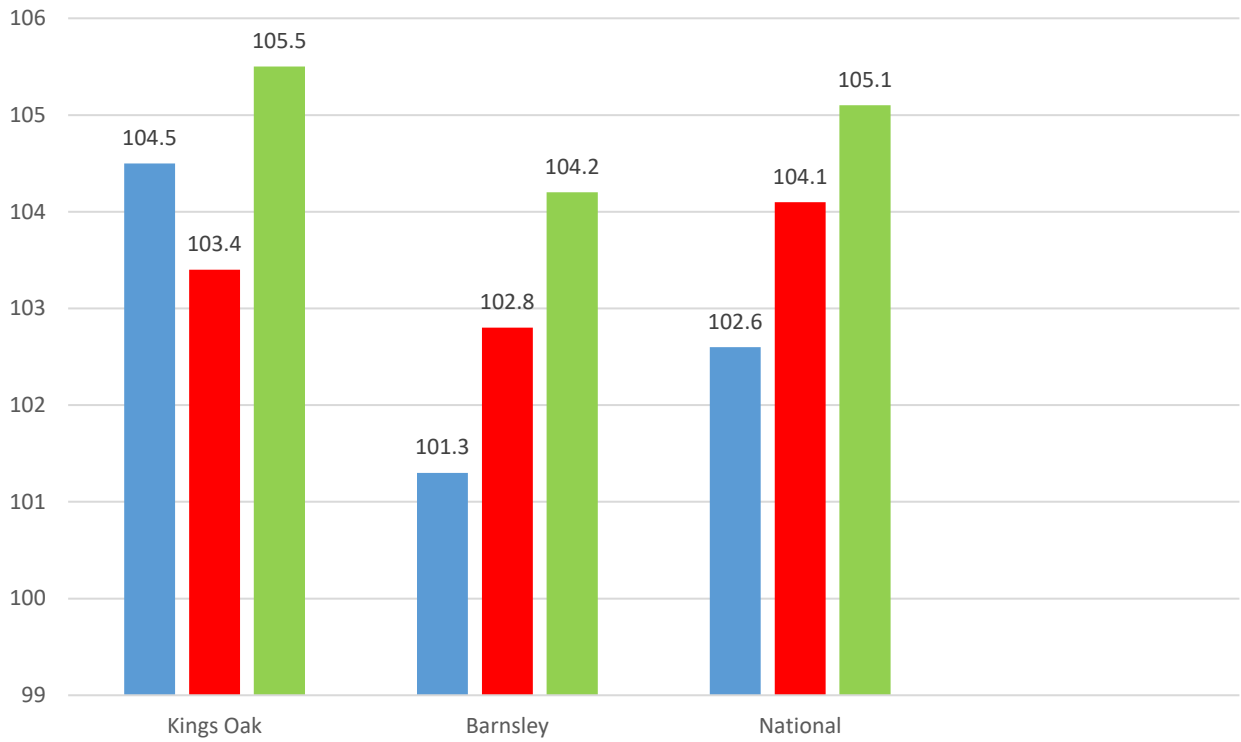


More focus has been put on speed and inference in comprehension and this has impacted significantly on the results. 19.9% rise since 2016 – well above National.



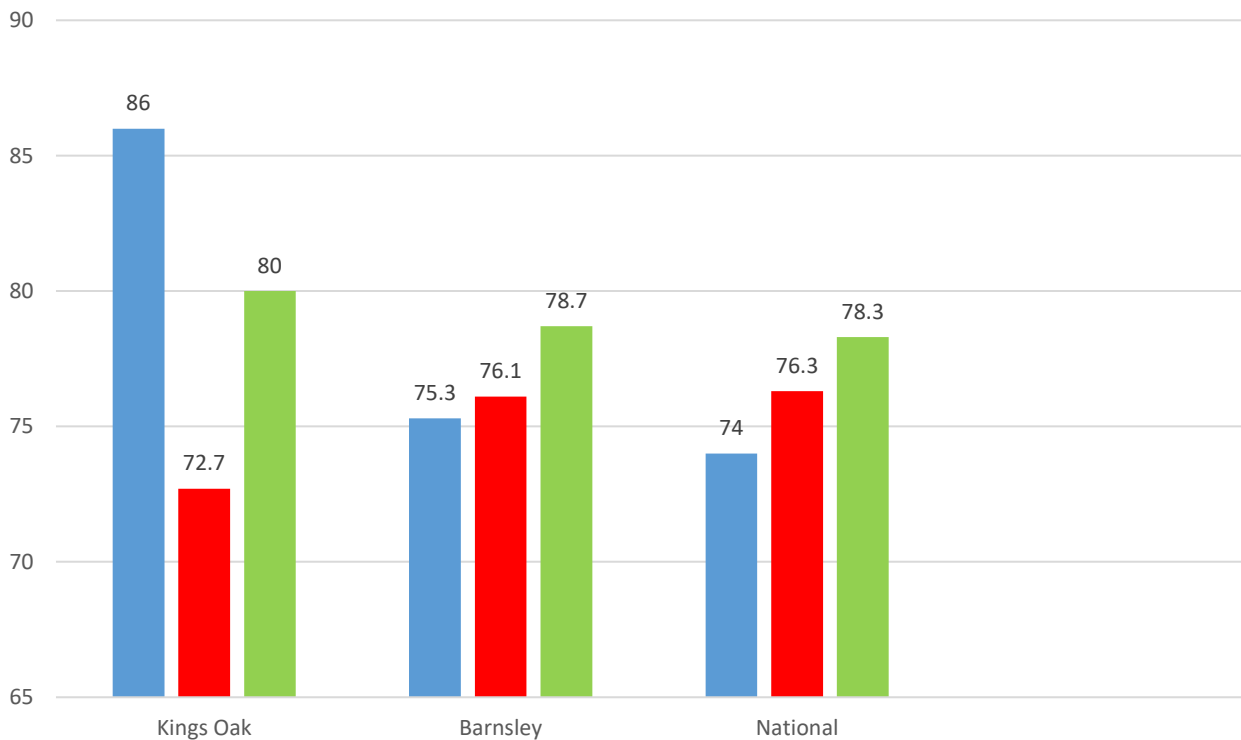
Although there have been improvements in children achieving greater depth in reading the gap has widened at National and this is a key focus for school improvement.

Reading average scaled scores 2016 -2018



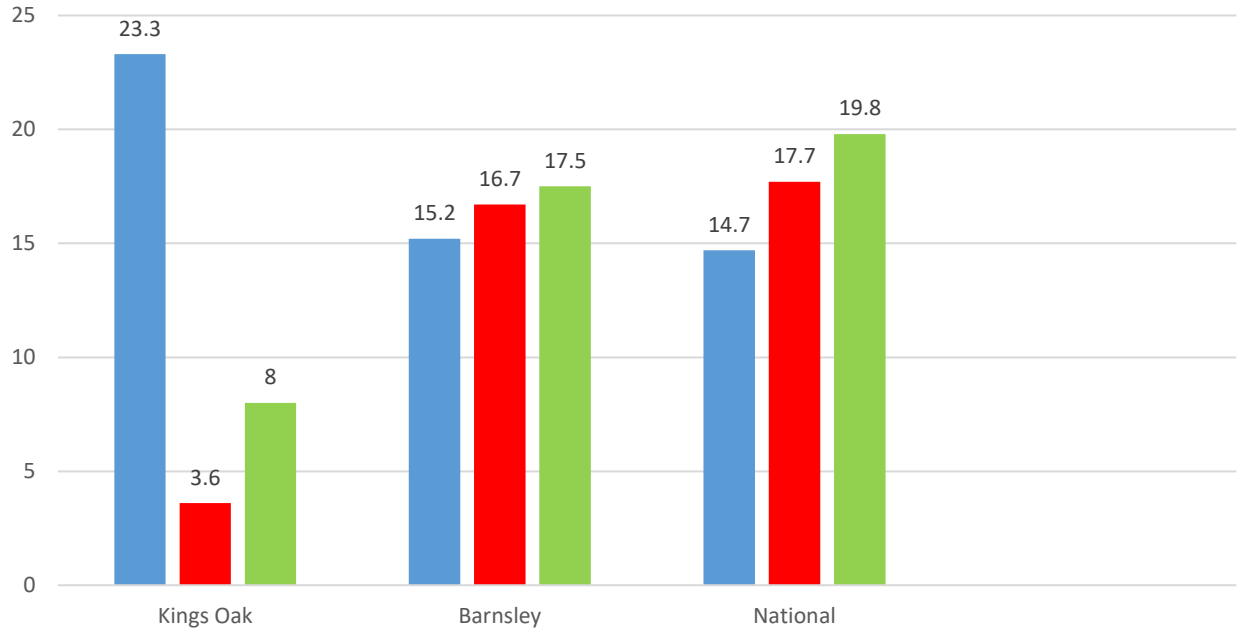
Kings Oak scaled score improved in reading and is in line with National

Writing 2016-2018 - achieved standard



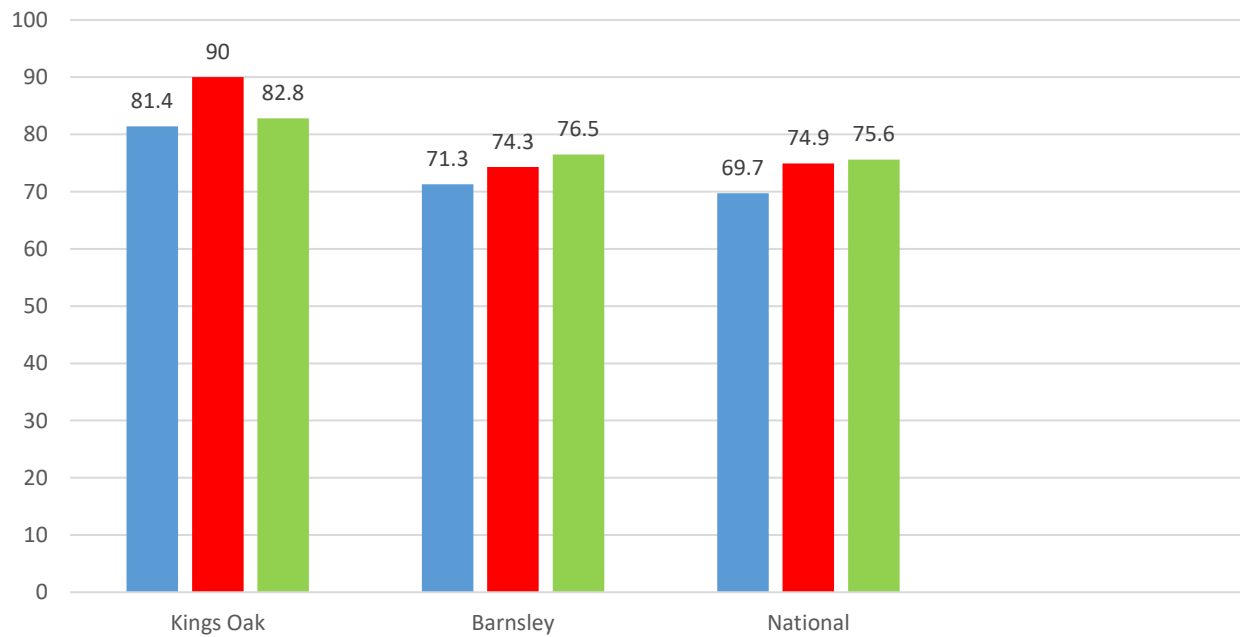
Fluctuating pattern – above National, but an area which remains high priority – cohort for 2016 was extremely strong

Writing 2016 - 2018- high attainers

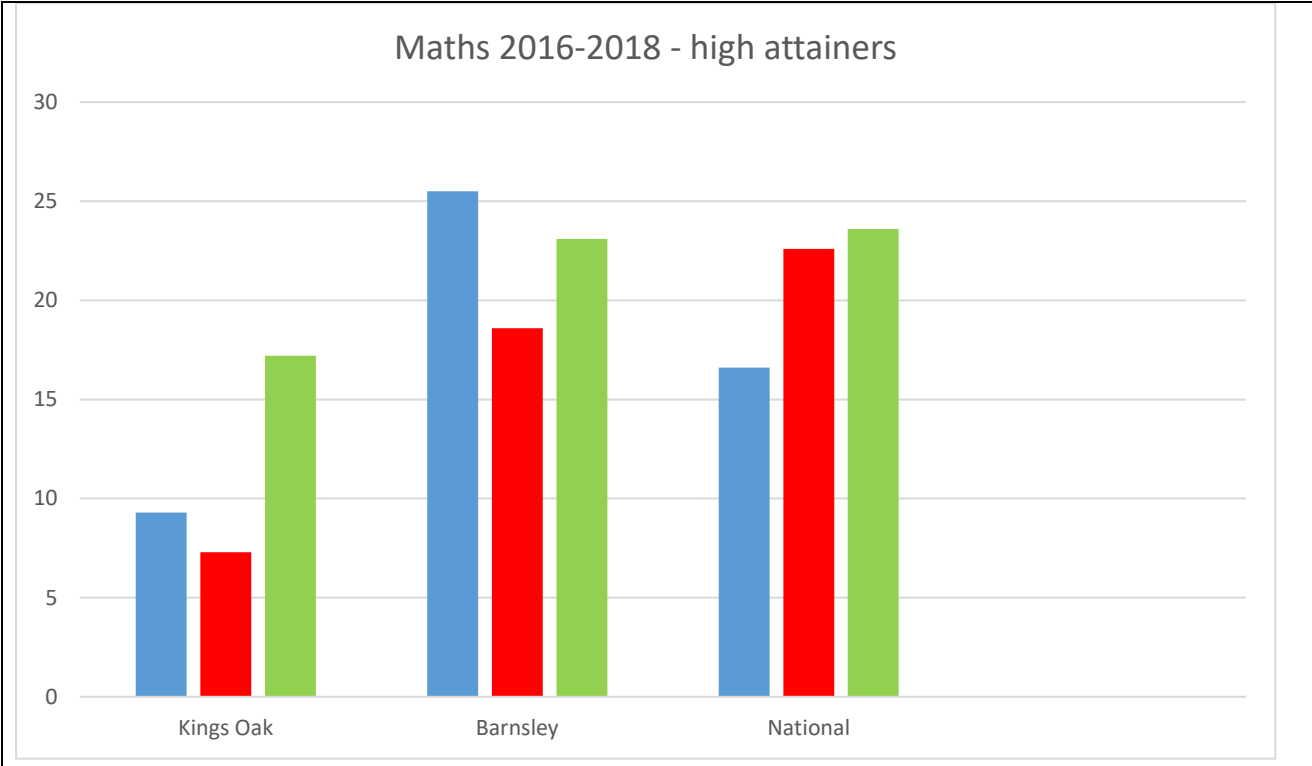


Gap remains wide at greater depth writing and is the key focus for improvement.

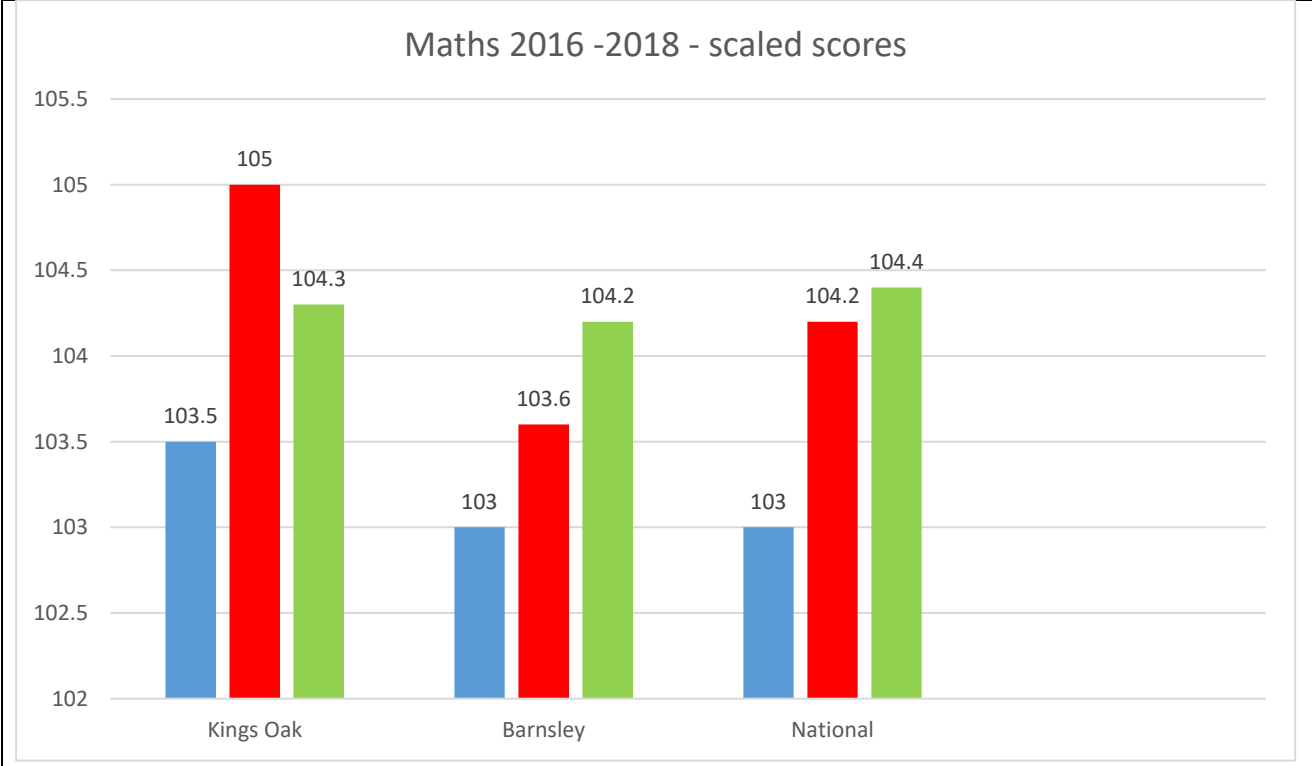
Maths -2016 -2018- achieved standard



Kings Oak remains above National consecutively for three years in Maths, decline from last year purely cohort representation

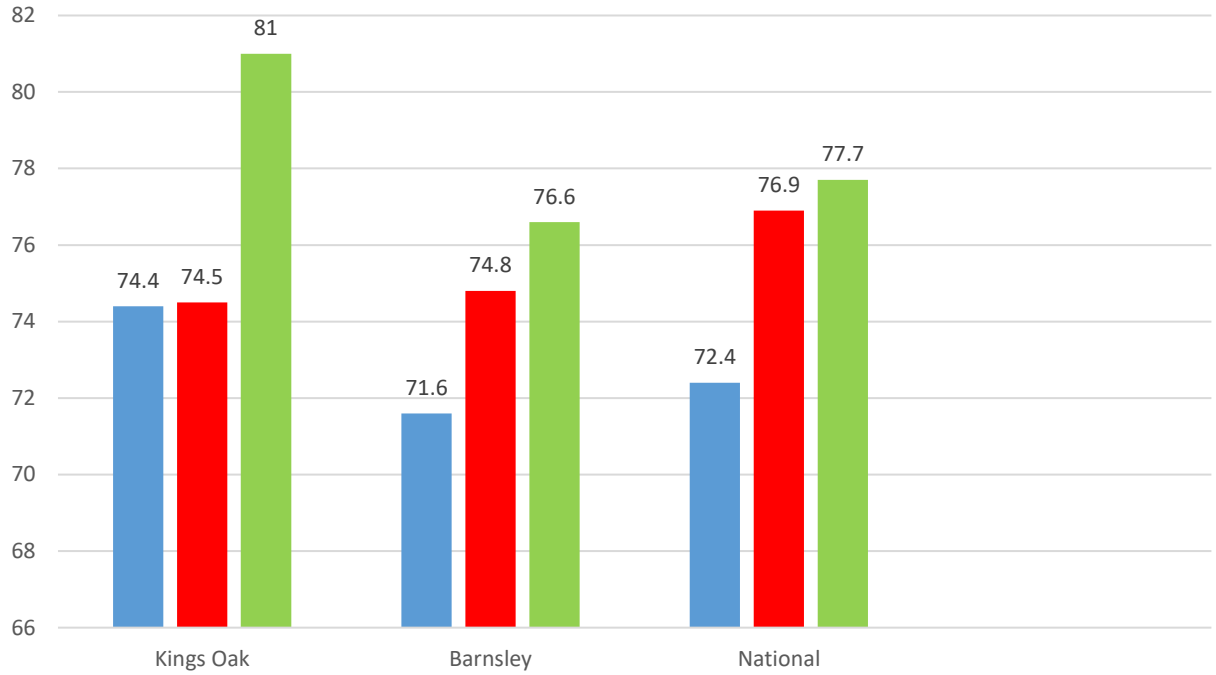


9.9% rise since 2017 – gap closing to National still a key focus for improvement



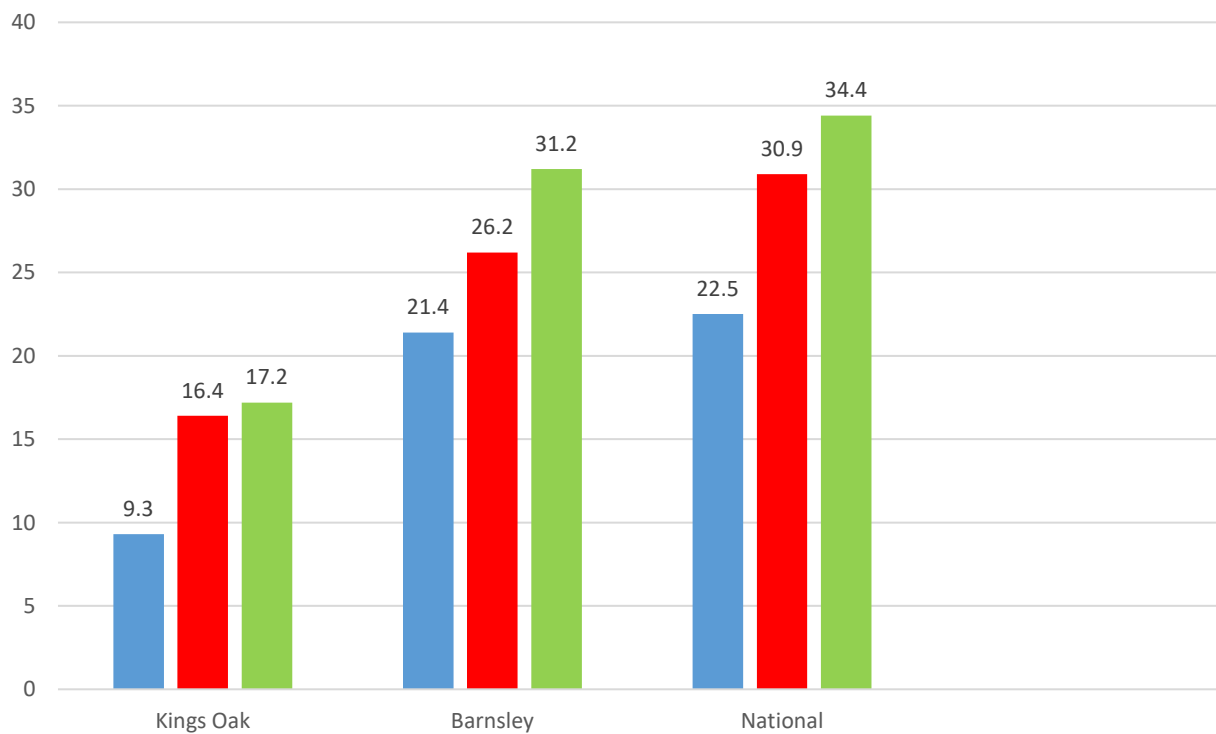
Slight decrease in scaled score but still broadly in line with National

GPS - 2016 - 2018 achieved standard

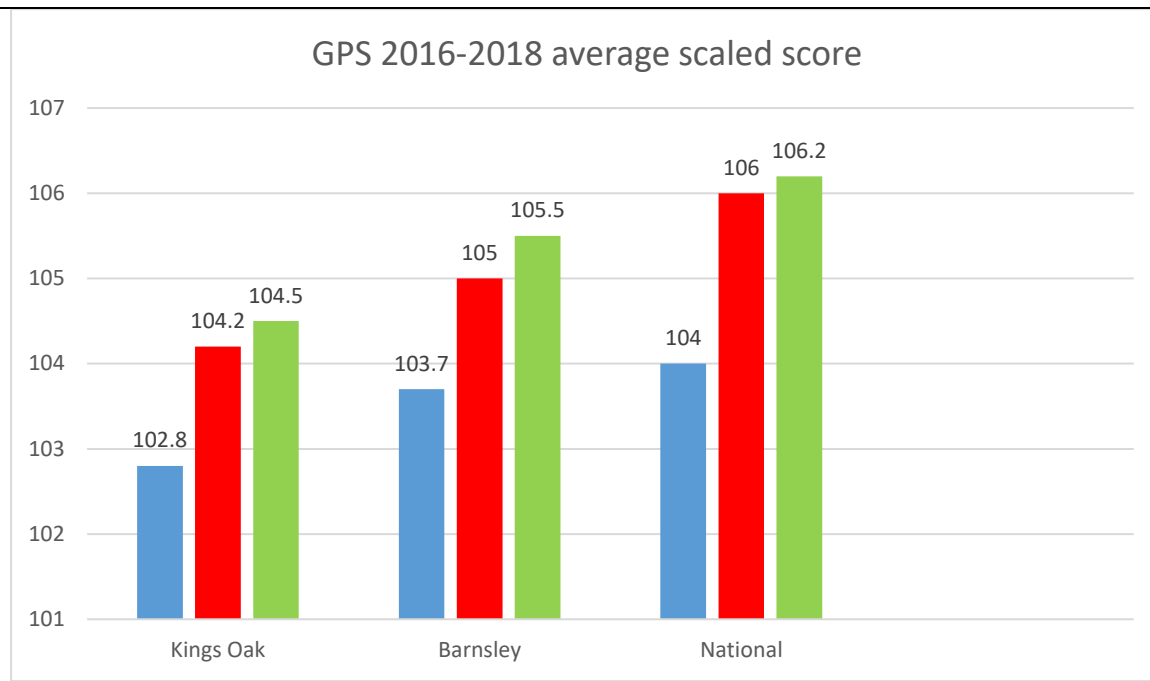


Good improvements this year, more focused spelling work is now having a greater impact and GPS is embedded through school

GPD - 2016 -2018 - high attainers



7.9% rise since 2016, but still a big gap to close therefore with writing it remains a priority



1.7 rise since 2016, but gap slightly increasing therefore spelling and grammar remain a priority

RWM combined 2016 60.5 national 53.2 2017 Kings Oak combined 60 – National 61

RWM 2018 74.1 – National 64.3 although a fluctuating pattern pleasing to see impact of good teaching to achieve this result.

RWM high attainers 2016 Kings Oak 0% - National 5.4%

2017 6.6 % Kings Oak – National 8.7%

2018 Kings Oak 8% - National 9.8%
