Literacy – including Phonics

- Start phase 2 phonics

- Start to write the starting sound in words
 - Write own name clearly
 - Begin to read words and simple sentences
- Enjoying sharing and talking about stories

Mathematics

- Recognise numerals to 20
 - Count objects to 20
- Count out 6 objects from a larger group
 - Naming 2d and 3d shapes
 - Use positional language

- Talk about family members and their traditions



Expressive Art and Design

- Join in familiar songs and rhymes
- Explore the different sounds of instruments
