



English

We will begin by focusing on different fiction genres. Then we will look at explanations, recounts and reports. We will be reading a range of different texts including fiction, non-fiction and poetry.



PE

In indoor PE, we will be focusing on dance and gymnastics and football outside.

History / Geography

We will be covering the topic 'Crime and Punishment'. We will look at how this area has changed over time.



MFL

We will be recapping some of the key vocabulary and focusing on 'the family' and 'the weather'



Mathematics

We will start with place, factors, multiples and prime numbers. We will explore mental and written methods for all 4 operations and problem solving. Then we will look at fractions, decimals and percentages. Shape properties and angles will also be covered.



Science

In Science we will be looking at how light travels, and circuit work involving switches, buzzers and changing circuits to suit different needs.



Computing

We will be looking at digital sounds and sound recording, understanding all of the different ways these are used and can be created.

In Art, we will be looking at Banksy and in music we will be exploring different types of music and exploring song lyrics.
