Attendance

As a Local Authority School we are required to monitor attendance and set targets to improve the attendance of all our pupils. Any absences will impact on your child's learning. For children to make the best possible progress it is vital that they attend School, on time, every day unless the reason for the absence is unavoidable.

Good attendance means being in School at least 95% of the time. We reward good attendance each term by presenting certificates to all children who attend at, or above this level.

This term all children who attend at least 95% of the term will have their names entered into a raffle and one child will win our termly star prize.



School Library

Sharing stories with your child is an important part of them learning to read and to support this we have a School Library which all children use. Every FRIDAY your child will have the opportunity to change their School library book. We ask that books are kept in school book bags and brought to School every day.

Smile 4 Life

Rosegrove Nursery School operates a healthy eating policy and has achieved the 'Smile 4 life' accreditation. This means that children are offered milk or water to drink, (no juice or cordial or fizzy drinks), and healthy options for meal times. We also ask that parents who provide their children with a packed lunch also follow the Smile 4 life guidelines.
