Unfortunately many children are not taught this vital lesson until it is too late, and their parents learn the hard way.

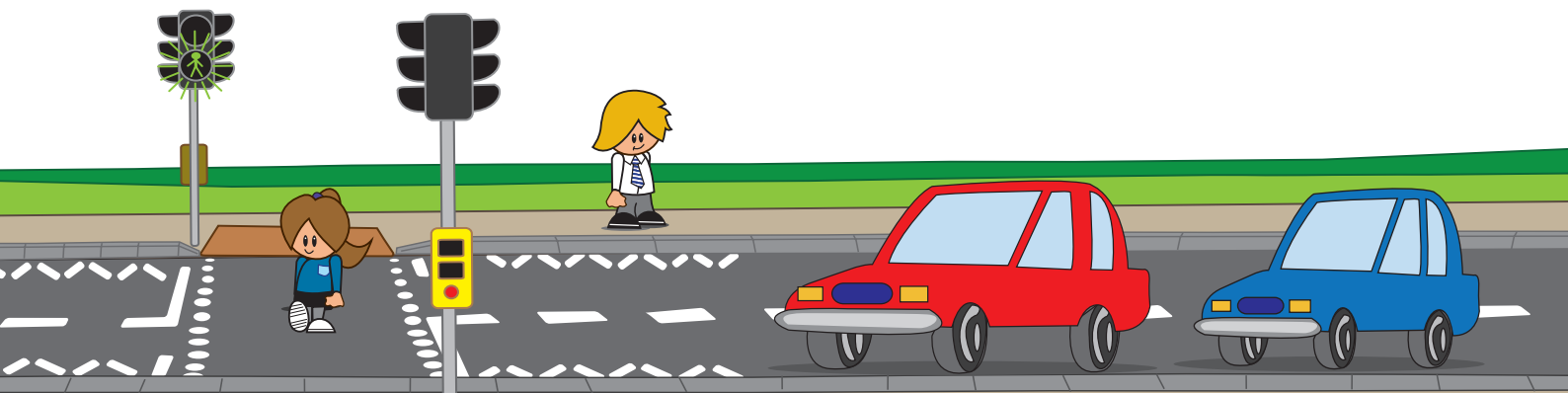
Part of the training will take place in the classroom, however the important part of the training will be out of school, at the road side, under strict supervision.
