School Meals

Please remember to apply to Derbyshire County Council for a secondary school place for them. Even if you have already approached a school, or feel you have put your child's name down at a school, you need to make an application. The closing date for applications is midnight on the Wednesday, 31 October 2018. You can fill an application form – either online - www.derbyshire.gov.uk/admissions, by phone – 01629 537499 – this takes approximately 15 minutes.
