PE

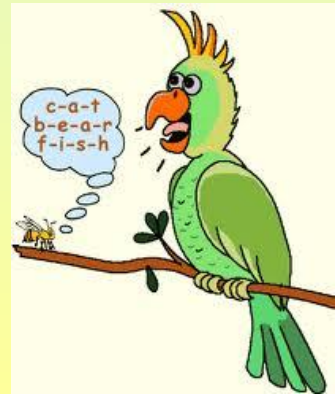
- Long hair tied back
