As you are aware this is an exciting learning opportunity, where the children get to experience learning in an outside environment. To make the experience as enjoyable as possible the children need to wear appropriate clothing for the weather.

Clothing: all clothing should be old as it **will** get muddy! The school can provide wellington boots and waterproof trousers for all the children if required.

Long sleeve T-shirts/ tops – even if the weather is hot so arms are protected.
