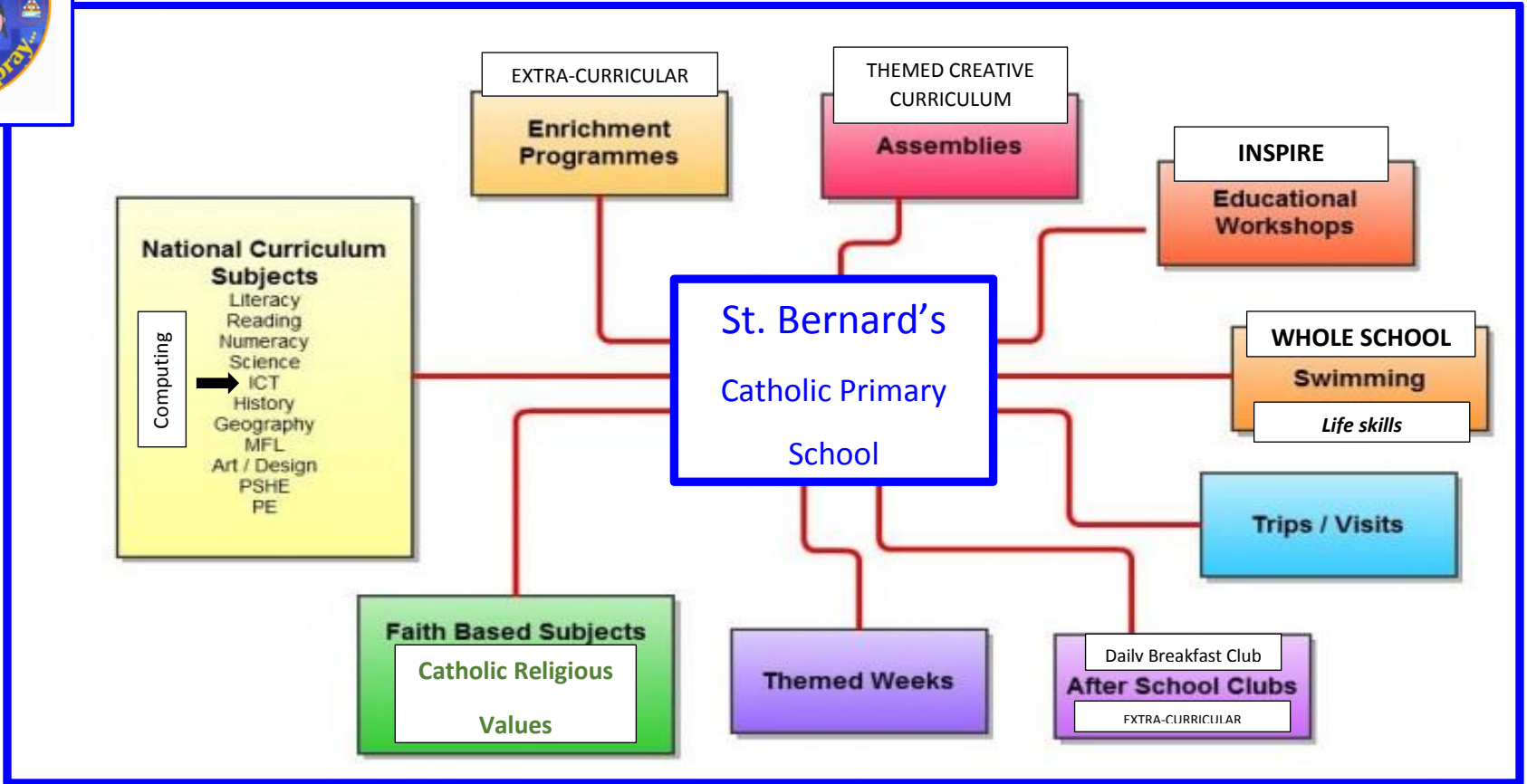


Whole School Creative Curriculum Approach

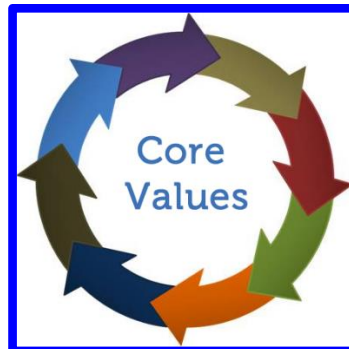
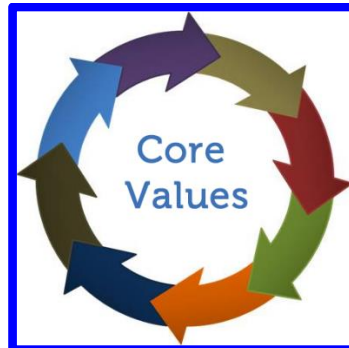
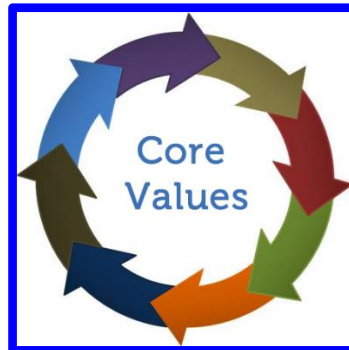
Our common *teaching and learning* goals in school every day are related to being:

ART/DESIGN focus
