As we start a new Academic Year - here are a few reminders to help everyone stay safe in school.

- School gates will open at 08.40am and are locked at 15.45pm. Late arrivals need to buzz the gate and state who they are and who they have come to see before the gate is unlocked. Please note that if you are late you might need to wait a few minutes to be admitted into the grounds.
- Cars are NOT ALLOWED down the school drive at ANY TIME. Parking permits are available from the School Office. These entitle parking on Fairview Car Park from 8.25am - 9.10am and from 3pm-3.45pm.
- Access into school is only possible via the School Office during the day so please buzz at the gate, announce who you are and wait to be admitted onto the school grounds. You will then need to buzz the front door at Reception where a member of staff will let you in. Please sign in and you will be given a Visitor's Pass to wear whilst on the premises. Please sign out when you leave and give your Pass back to the Office staff.
- Mobile phones MUST be SWITCHED OFF whilst on the school site.
- The use of cameras by parents and visitors is STRICTLY FORBIDDEN unless permission is given by the Headteacher during a school event i.e. Christmas Fayre.
- School climbing equipment must be used under close supervision of parents before and after school. We are not responsible for accidents that happen before 08.50am or after 15.30pm.
- PLEASE read the weekly newsletter. It gives you valuable information about what is happening in school. Make sure you read any Parentmail emails and texts as these also give you important information. Teachers might also put notices on their windows if they want to inform you of something specific to your child's class.
