- ▶ PE days – Monday (AM) and Wednesday (PM).

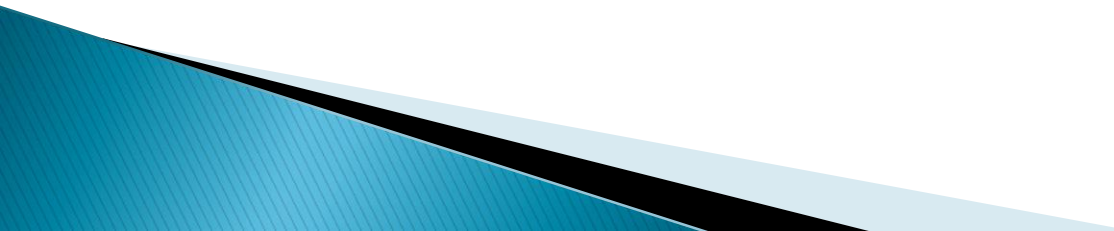
Inside PE

- ▶ **ALL KIT NEEDS TO BE LABELLED**

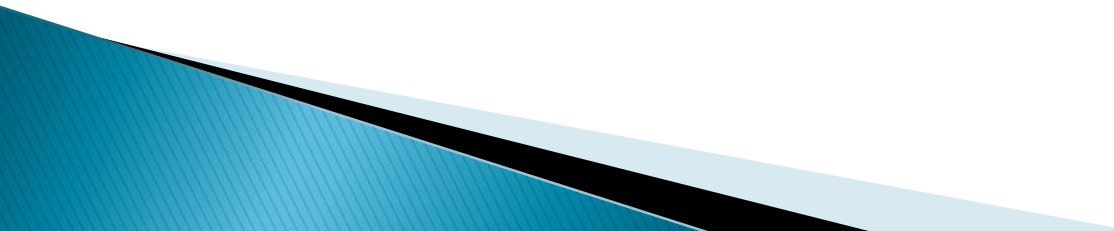
Routines

 - ▶ Water bottles should be in school daily.
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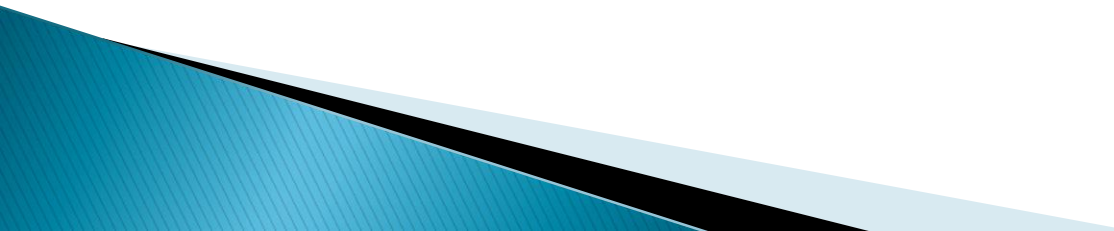
Snack

Homework

- ▶ Handed out on **Friday** in reading folder. Usually will be phonics sheets to be completed.

 - ▶ Children will be able to choose a new library book each Monday.
 - ▶ Reading books will be given out once the children have learned the alphabet sounds.
 - ▶ Please make sure you sign the reading record so we know it has been read
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Phonics delivery – Reception

- ▶ The main phonics programme is delivered in Reception and Y1.
 - ▶ Children learn the sounds that letters make to enable them to blend words together for reading and then segment for writing.
 - ▶ There will be a phonics session for parents in Autumn 2.
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Rewards

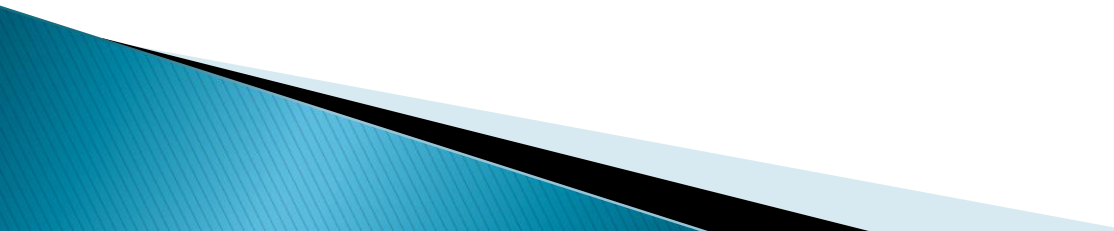
