If there is an issue we would want to know before Parents Evening and want to know sooner.  
Be firmer on bullies and deal with it effectively.  
Share out roles / tasks / responsibilities / parts in plays etc more equally among the children  
More TA support in class  
Can you improve the road parking? Maybe the presence of a PCSO in the morning to speak to parents?  
Can't think of anything – very happy  
Teaching children more on emotional intelligence  
Outside Year 2 – dig up and reset flags on the floor (where flooding occurs)  
More arts & crafts. Are these being squashed out of the curriculum at national level?  
Not sure you can – it's great!  
Continue the parent workshops  
Continue to offer the same support to all the children and remain approachable with parents  
Provide before and after school care. Brocks has been full for the last 3-4 years  
I don't think you can – it's great  
Just keep doing what you're doing  
Additional parents evening in the summer to get an update on progress  
More opportunities to work with children from other schools – competitions & transition stuff  
Teaching on 'skills for life' – well-being, resilience, confidence, hormones, friendships, self-awareness, team building  
Decorating communal areas such as hall etc.  
Fixing blinds, washing paintwork & general overhaul to spruce up  
Huge injection of cash to build a school building in keeping with the quality of teaching.
