Dear Parents,

Welcome to this weeks newsletter.

We have had a very busy full week back; the children have all begun their new topics and seem to be enjoying the new class splits.

For swimming and PE the children will be in their registration classes not in any sets they may be in. If you are unsure which registration group your child is in and they are unable to tell you, please ask any member of staff who will be able to help you with this.

You will be sent out a class letter over the next two weeks, which have your child's spellings, and books we recommend for their age group. These will be sent out with the children's English groups. We will also be sending out a maths letter explaining the times tables requirements for each year group. We do ask that you continue to support your child by: listening to them read, reading to them, asking questions about what you are reading and discussing vocabulary with them. We also ask you to practise their times tables at home as learning these makes all maths learning much more accessible to them %, fractions, multiplications and area to name a few. Curriculum overviews showing the children's topic learning will be on the school website during the coming weeks.

If your child has a medical condition which requires medication e.g. asthma, please make sure that you fill out a medical plan. These are available on the website under the parents section , or in the letter rack by the school office.

We are happy for the children to trade Lego cards during break and lunch times, but will not be dealing with falling outs regarding 'bad swaps' which impinges on learning time! Please could you remind your child of this.

Next week will be the start of all our Year R children coming to school all day—do expect very tired children by Friday. We have all been really impressed with how well they have settled into school life!

Clubs start next week—do look on the noticeboard on the playground to check which club your child has a place in. These are not done on a first come, first served basis, we do try to ensure every child has at least one club of their choice to keep it fair. Remember all clubs finish at 4.15p.m. They will continue until the week ending Friday 7th December.

You will have had a year planner sent home with you today which will have all our current dates on it—these are subject to change (although we do try not to change them as much as possible). We will be updating it through the school year and will notify you when we make changes. This is also available on the school website.

**Admissions to primary school for September 2019.** If your child was born between 1st September 2014 and 31st August 2015 it is now time to apply for a primary school. Online application will open on Monday 17th September and will close on 15th January 2019. Please make sure you apply between these dates otherwise you may not get your first choice of school.
