Home Learning – Topic Project

‘This is me’

This term’s whole school topic is ‘Mirrors, Windows, Doors’ which will have links with Geography, History and PSHE. This term’s home learning will focus on the ‘mirrors’ aspect of our topic, this will give children the opportunity to reflect inward on themselves; explore their own insights; think about what makes them the person they are as well as exploring their own attitudes and growth mind-set.

This term’s home learning task is to complete a ‘**This is me**’ project. Children are to present information about themselves so their teacher can learn more about each individual, their future hopes and dreams and their family.

Ideas **could** include:

- A self portrait
- Photographs
- A fact file / list of attributes
- A family tree
- A timeline of important family events
- Information about hobbies and extra-curricular activities
- Hopes/dreams/aspirations for the future
- Information about family name
- A design of a family shield

Important reminders:

- This project could be typed (and stuck into books), written by hand or a combination of both.
- There is **no expectation** with quantity, time spent on task or style.
- The project is compulsory for Key Stage 2 pupils and optional for Key Stage 1 pupils.

Enjoy putting the project together, we can’t wait to read them and see how the project has been interpreted.
