

End of Key Stage 2 Performance Data 2018

The tests assess pupils against a national standard for:

- Maths;
- Reading;
- Grammar, punctuation and spelling.

There is not a test for writing at the end of Key Stage 2. Year 6 teachers make an assessment judgement against national criteria which is moderated by the Senior Leadership Team.
