What you can expect of us

The school will:

- Ensure you child's physical and social well-being at all times and foster feelings of confidence, self-worth and belonging.
- Deliver a balanced and carefully planned curriculum which meets the needs of your individual child.
- Provide a range of extra-curricular activities designed to enrich your child's experience.
- Ensure that homework tasks are given on agreed days and that they reflect your child's learning.
- Actively welcome parents/carers into the life of the school and ensure that teaching staff are always available by mutual arrangement to discuss any questions or concerns you might have about your child's progress or general welfare.
- Respect the views of parents and children, acknowledging differences.
- Ensure that bullying and other discriminating behaviour is not tolerated.
- Use rewards and sanctions fairly, and in line with our behaviour policy.
- Celebrate your child's academic and personal achievements.
- Care for your child's safety.
- Regularly meet with you to communicate the progress of your child, explaining how we can support their areas of development.

What we can expect of you

I/We undertake to:

- Ensure that my child attends school regularly and that absences are notified by 9.30 a.m. each day.
- Ensure that my child arrives promptly at the beginning of the day and is collected promptly at the end of the school day.
- Support the school's policies and guidelines on behaviour and anti-bullying.
- Support my child in his/her homework and wherever possible promote opportunities for learning with me at home.
- Read at home as often as possible. (Try to aim for once a day. Reading can take place in many forms- comics, books, bug club, bedtime stories.....)
- Ensure that my child goes to bed at a reasonable time on weekdays.
- Attend parent's evenings and any other meetings about my child's education.
- See that my child wears the correct school uniform and has the correct P.E. kit in school each day.
- Read all information sent home and respond to any correspondence as necessary.
- Let the school know of any concerns or worries that may be affecting my child's learning or ability to do homework.
- Encourage a positive attitude towards my child's education and our school. If I have any concerns, I will come and discuss them with the school to work out a solution.
