Include some wintry words e.g. snow, ice, cold, frozen.</p>	<p><b><u>Science</u></b></p> <p>Find out about the weather in the North Pole. Write down what you have found out.</p>	<p><b><u>Art</u></b></p> <p>Create an arctic landscape using an art media of your choice (E.g. paint, colouring pencils, collage)</p>
<p><b><u>ICT</u></b></p> <p>Research a country which is in the Arctic circle. Write down the name of the country and draw it's flag.</p>	<p><b><u>D + T</u></b></p> <p>Create an arctic or Antarctic themed shoebox habitat.</p>	<p><b><u>Music</u></b></p> <p>Listen to a song from the Frozen soundtrack. What instruments can you hear?</p>	<p><b><u>Geography</u></b></p> <p>Create a poster about your local area. What do you like and dislike about where you live?</p>
<p><b><u>RE</u></b></p> <p>Draw/take a picture of you in a place that is special. Write about why it is special to you.</p>	<p><b><u>Science</u></b></p> <p>Find out about an animal which lives in the North or South Pole. Draw the animal and label it's features.</p>	<p><b><u>PE</u></b></p> <p>Imagine you are snowflake. Create a dance as a snowflake. Think carefully about your movements.</p>	<p><b><u>English</u></b></p> <p>Imagine you have been on an expedition to the North Pole. Write a diary entry for 1 day of your expedition.</p>
