Communication and Language Choose something that is special to you to bring in and share with the rest of the class for show and tell.	Personal, Social and Emotional Development What do you think makes a good friend? Talk about this with somebody at home. Why are you a good friend?	Physical Development Please practice getting dressed/ undressed independently, including fastening shoes. Can you time how fast you can do this?
Literacy Look at your favourite book with an adult and tell them all about the characters and what happens in the story. Bring your story in to share.	Mathematics Draw around the handprints of everyone in your family. Can you cut them out and put them in order of size, from the smallest handprint to the largest handprint?	Understanding the World Have a look at some photographs of you as a baby. What changes have happened? Bring a baby picture in to show.
	Expressive Arts and Design Can you create a shoe box penguin landscape with your grown up?	

This term our topic is called Poles Apart it begins with learning about the South Pole.

I would suggest doing 1 of the homework activities per week alongside your daily reading.

Your child will choose a reading book (initially without or with very few words) to share with somebody at home. We encourage the children to read at least three times per week. The more reading you share with your child the greater their progress in all areas of their learning will be.
