

Evaluation of SDP 2017-18

We have had another successful year:

- Outstanding assessment results in EYFS - GLD is 81.7% .In 2017 National was 71% ,
- Year 1 phonic screen results were high again with 88% meeting the standard. From the Year 2 re-screens there was a decrease from 95% to 75% with 4 children out of 16 not achieving the standard—this will be a focus for our English lead 18-19
- Key stage 1 results were outstanding again with very pleasing results in greater depth. In reading 89% were at the expected standard or above (43%GD), in writing 84% at expected or above (32% GD) and in maths 87% at expected or above (35% GD)
- We gained an award from Together for Children for outstanding commitment to Anti-bullying, our team will be going for Platinum status next year.
- The key stage 1 outdoor classroom is now being showcased to other schools across the whole North East, which is also generating income to the Trust
- We were re-accredited with the Early Years Charter Mark
- A whole school review was undertaken by a consultant who agreed with our outstanding judgements in our SEF
- Cross moderation of EYFS and KS1 assessments with another Infant School—verified school judgements

Challenges to 2018—2019 include:

- Budget constraints
- Drop in numbers in nursery, and 30 hour offer
- New business manager in post— VLT stability
- Removal of P scales

However there will also be new opportunities:

- Strengthening partnerships at Trust level
- Continuing development of the outdoor classroom
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This plan identifies the priorities that are key to whole school improvement and will form the basis for staff appraisals.

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
